



Enterprise Resource Planning

Under People First, the NSW Government's Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Strategic Plan, a new whole-of-government strategic direction has been developed for the procurement of government corporate applications to change the way agencies buy, implement and support their Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) systems. Whilst the focus in the past has been on reducing the acquisition costs of these investments, greater opportunities exist for agencies to manage the total cost of ownership of corporate applications through lifecycle management.

The Oracle ERP GSAS Contract 2600, SAP ERP GSAS Contract 2601, Mincom ERP GSAS Contract 2603 and Systems Implementation and Managed Services (SIMS) (2020A) replace the following GSAS contracts that expired on 31 December 2007:

- Contract 2321 - Human Resource and Payroll Management Systems (HRMS),
- Contract 2322 - Financials Management Systems (FMS),
- Contract 2143 - Integrated Management Systems (IMS), and
- Contract 2311 - Oracle Common Use Software

Many agencies have already achieved significant benefit through the use of the new GSAS contracts.

ELIGIBLE CUSTOMERS INCLUDE

These contracts are available to those organizations defined as:

- the agencies and other bodies employing members of the "public sector service", as that term is defined in section 3 of the Public Sector Employment and Management Act 2002; (PSEMA 2002).
